Removing the mains input cover will expose you to a voltage hazard of up to 575V. This equipment contains Ensure the mains input power hazardous voltages that is off and locked out before removing cover.

Before removing top cover, wait at least 20 minutes after isolating AC power to allow the high voltage capacitors to discharge.

Always wear appropriately rated safety equipment when from compressor in working around equipment and/or components energized with high voltage.

1 - Introduction:

2 - CAPACITOR COVER ASSEMBLY Removal Instructions:

- 1. Isolate compressor power as described in Section "Electrical Isolation of the Compressor" of the Service Manual (M-SV-001).
- 2. Remove the top covers.
- 3. Remove the Capacitor Cover.
- 4. Remove the nylon nuts from the base of the DC Capacitor Assembly.
- 5. Remove the capacitor relief membrane.

3 - CAPACITOR COVER ASSEMBLY Installation Instruction:

- 1. Install the new capacitor relief membrane with the foam side up.
- 2. Install the nylon nuts to the base of the DC capacitor assembly.
- 3. Install the Capacitor Cover.
- 4. Install the top covers.
- 5. Return the compressor to normal operation.
