1 - Introduction

2 - O-RINGS – SUCTION, DISCHARGE, ECONOMIZER, MOTOR COOLING PORTS Removal Instructions:

1. Isolate compressor power.
2. Isolate the compressor and recover the refrigerant according to industry standards.
3. Remove and discard the old O-rings.

3 - O-RINGS – SUCTION, DISCHARGE, ECONOMIZER, MOTOR COOLING PORTS Installation Instructions:

1. Ensure the O-ring location is clean and free from all contamination.
2. Remove each O-ring to be installed from its package and inspect for damage or defects.
3. Lubricate each O-ring.
4. Place appropriate O-ring in its specific location.
5. Leak test and evacuate compressor in accordance with standard industry practices.
6. Return the compressor to normal operation.

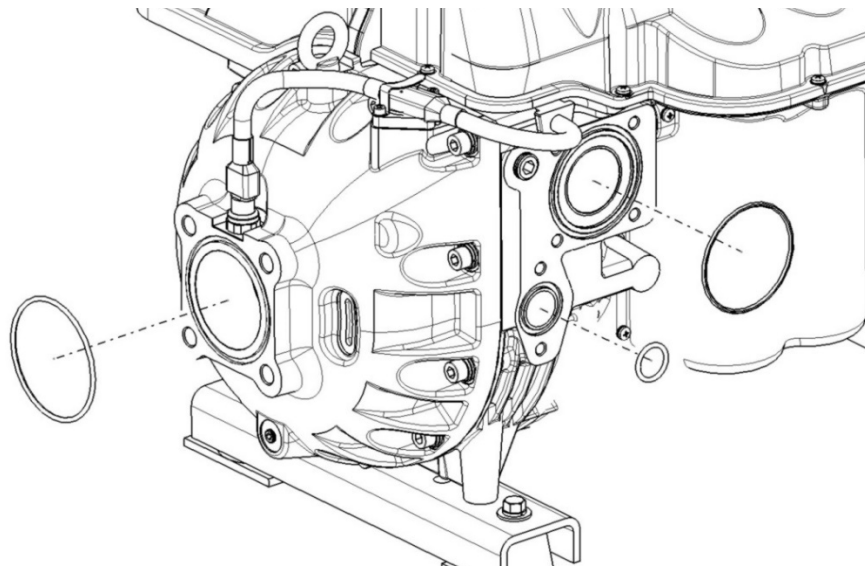


Figure 1 Suction, Discharge & Economizer

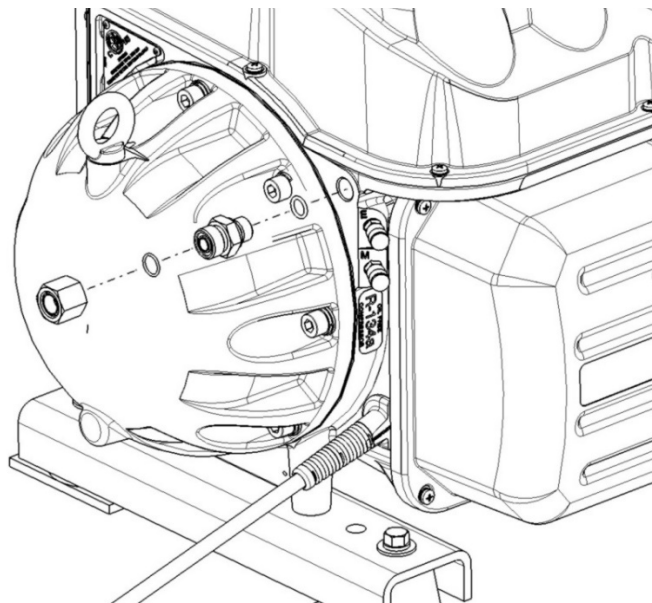










Figure 2 Cooling Adapter External & Internal
