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1 - Introduction

CABLE HARNESS FOR SOFT START AC/DC Removal and Installation Instructions.

There are two (2) variants of the DC-DC Converter mentioned in these instructions. There is a potted style and an open-frame style DC-DC Converter. The open-frame style utilizes three (3) connectors whereas the potted style uses four (4). The open-frame design no longer uses the 15VAC trigger signal from the Soft Start, thus eliminating the need for J4. Refer to the following two figures for proper identification of the two (2) DC-DC Converter styles.

Figure 1 – Open Frame DC-DC Converter

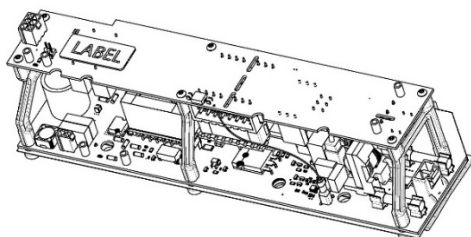
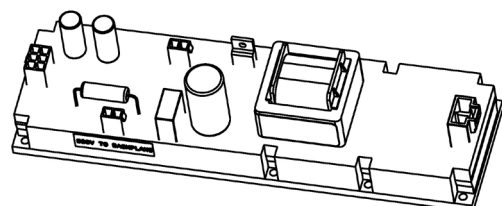


Figure 2 – Potted DC-DC Converter



This kit includes two (2) cables in order to accommodate either DC-DC Converter style.

2 - SOFT START CABLE HARNESS Removal Instructions:

1. Isolate compressor power as described in the Electrical Isolation of the Compressor section of the Service Manual (M-SV-001).
2. Remove the Mains Input Cover by releasing the fasteners that secure the Mains input cover and remove the cover.
3. Release the fasteners that secure the Top Cover and remove the cover.
4. Release the fasteners that secure the Service Cover and remove the cover.

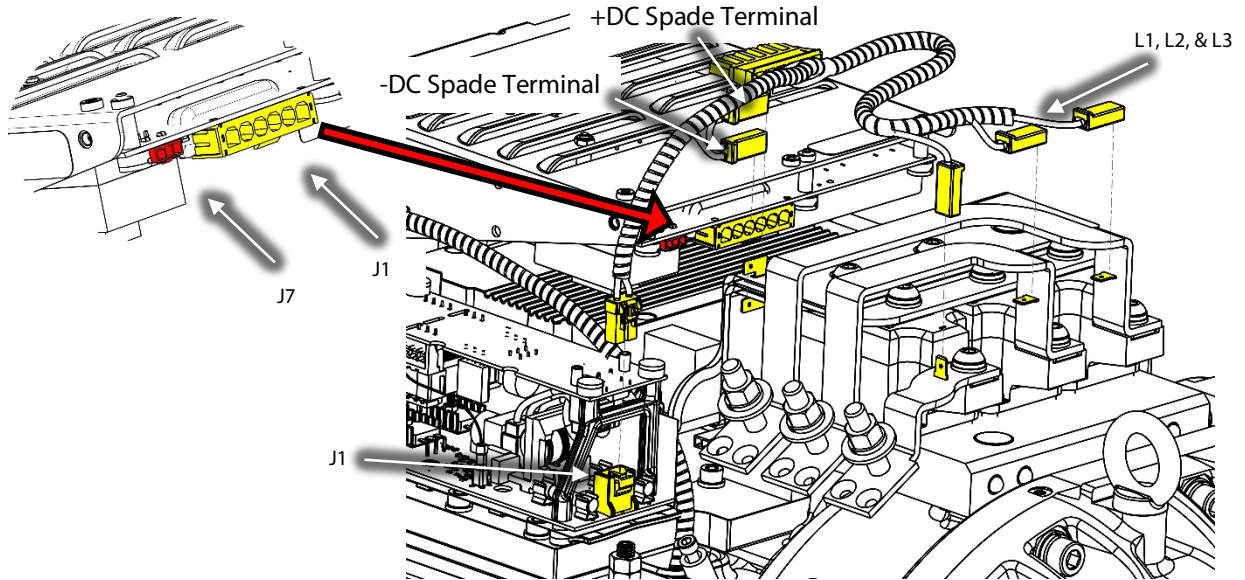


Figure 3 – Soft Start AC-DC Harness Removal

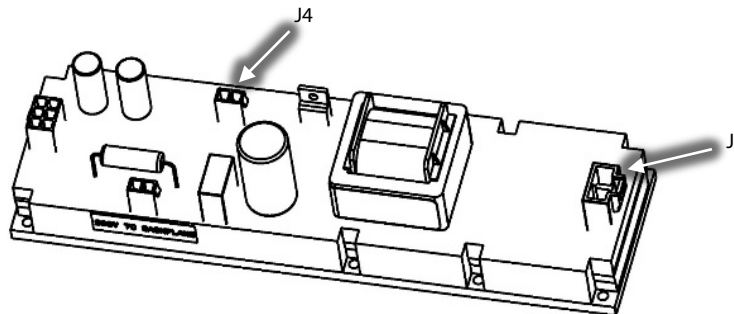


Figure 4 – Potted DC-DC Converter J1 and J4 Locations

5. Disconnect the three (3) spade terminals labeled L1, L2, and L3 from the AC bus bars. Refer to Figure 3 (Soft Start AC-DC Harness Removal) for this and the next three (3) steps.
6. Disconnect the -DC spade terminal from the -DC bus bar.
7. Disconnect the +DC ring terminal from the +DC bus bar.
8. Remove the J1 DC-DC connector from the DC-DC Converter. Refer to Figure 3 (Soft Start AC-DC Harness Removal) if this compressor contains the Open Frame DC-DC Converter, or to Figure 4 (Potted DC-DC Converter J1 and J4 Locations) if this is a Potted DC-DC Converter.
9. If the DC-DC Converter is the potted style, remove the J7 connector from the Soft Start. Refer to Figure 3 (Soft Start AC-DC Harness Removal).
10. If the DC-DC Converter is the potted style, remove the J4 connector from the DC-DC Converter. Refer to Figure 4 (Potted DC-DC Converter J1 and J4 Locations).
11. Remove the harness.

3 - SOFT START CABLE HARNESS Installation Instruction:

Note: Use harness **700371** for the potted DC-DC Converter and **701568** for the open frame DC-DC Converter.

1. Place the wiring harness on top of the compressor. Refer to Figure 3 (Soft Start AC-DC Harness Removal) for this and the next five (5) steps.
2. Install the "J1: High Voltage AC/DC" Soft Start connector.
3. Connect the +DC spade terminal to the +DC bus bar.
4. Connect the -DC spade terminal to the -DC bus bar.
5. Connect the three (3) spade terminals labeled L1, L2, and L3 from the AC bus bars
6. If the DC-DC Converter is the potted style, install the J7 Soft Start connector.
7. If the DC-DC Converter is the potted style, install the J4 DC-DC Converter connector. to Figure 4 (Potted DC-DC Converter J1 and J4 Locations).
8. Install the J1 DC-DC connector to the DC-DC Converter. Refer to Figure 3 (Soft Start AC-DC Harness Removal TT/TG Compressors) if this compressor contains the Open Frame DC-DC Converter, or to Figure 4 (Potted DC-DC Converter J1 and J4 Locations) if this is a Potted DC-DC Converter.
9. Install Covers. Refer to the Cover section below.
10. Reconnect power.

Cover Installation

1. Ensure that no dirt/debris is on the contact surfaces of Top Cover and casting sides.

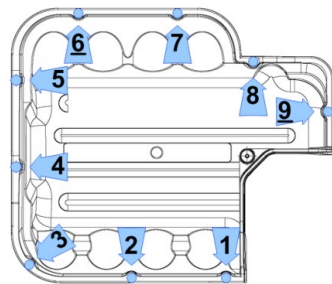


Figure 5 – Top Cover Install

2. Place the Top Cover and secure it with the fasteners according to the following sequence. Follow the sequence twice. The first time, only thread the fasteners half way down to allow for adjustments. Torque to 13 in.lb. on the second pass. Refer to Figure 5 (Top Cover Install).

3. Ensure that no dirt/debris is on the contact surfaces of the Mains Input Cover and casting sides.

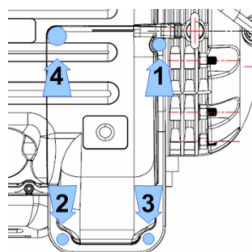


Figure 6 – Mains Input Cover Install

4. Place the New Mains Input Cover and secure it with the fasteners. Tighten according to the following sequence. Refer to Figure 6 (Mains Input Cover Install).



5. Follow the sequence twice. The first time, only thread the fasteners to half way down to allow for adjustment. Torque to 13 in.lb. on the second pass. Fasten the # 4 fastener only once and use caution as to not overtighten this fastener.
